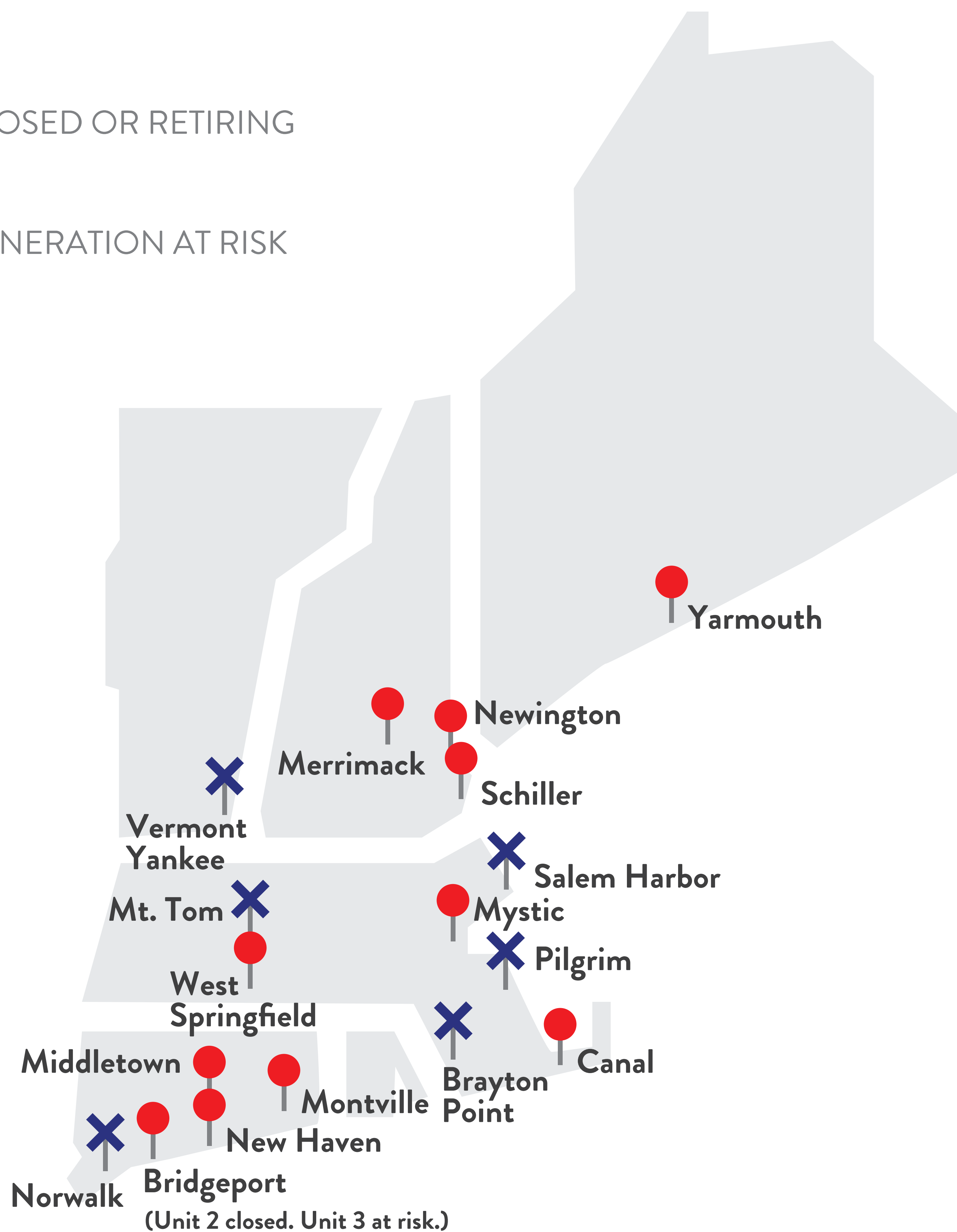
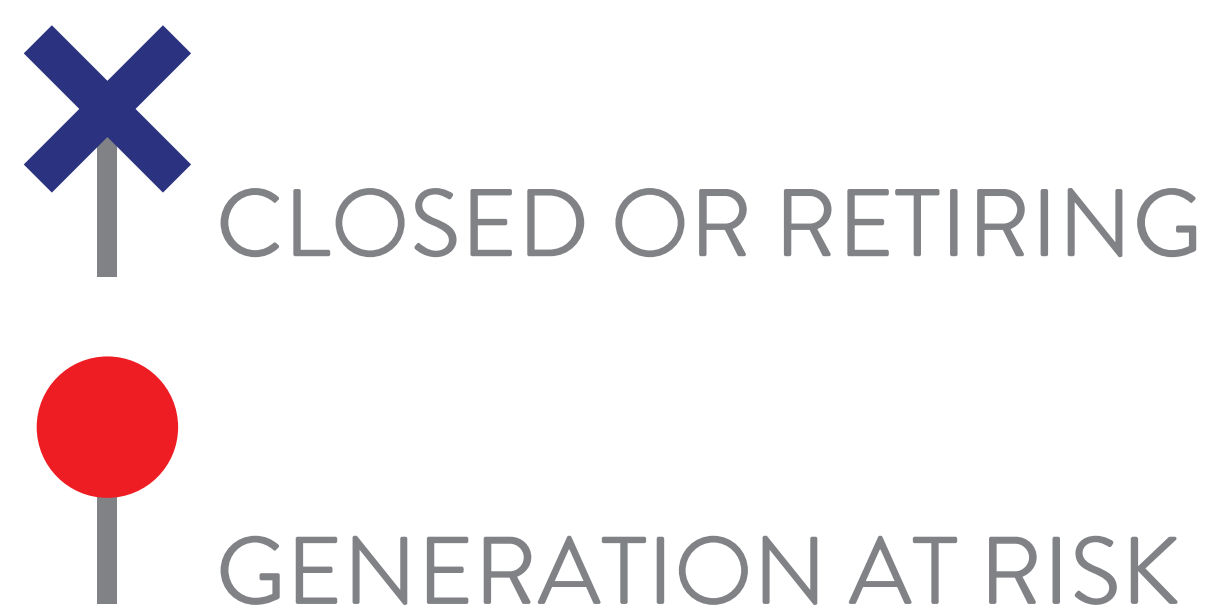


THE NEED
